TERROIR

Crafted since 1902, Clos du Marquis traces its origins to the Petit Clos, adjacent to Château Léoville Las Cases, the historic residence of the Marquis de Las Cases. Today, the heart of the Clos du Marquis terroir lies on the plateau of Saint-Julien, 20 meters above sea level and surrounded by some of Bordeaux's most renowned Second Growth estates. Located 500 meters west of the Grand Enclos of Las Cases, the 40-hectare vineyard rests on Quaternary gravel soils, older and finer than those of the Enclos. In this area, the vineyard sits on humic podzols over sandy-clay gravel. The high organic matter content at the surface further enhances the distinctive Saint-Julien character of Clos du Marquis.

VINTAGE 2025

The 2025 vintage of Clos du Marquis stands out for its structure, precision, and balance. The warm, sunny growing season was tempered by careful vineyard management throughout the growth cycle. A taller canopy was maintained to increase shading, helping to protect the fruit and preserve balance. The Cabernets from this terroir bring precision, length, and structure, while the Merlots contribute flesh, harmony, and vibrant fruit. Clos du Marquis 2025 is a serious and elegant Saint-Julien, combining density, freshness, and finesse, with the balance that defines the greatest vintages of this wine.

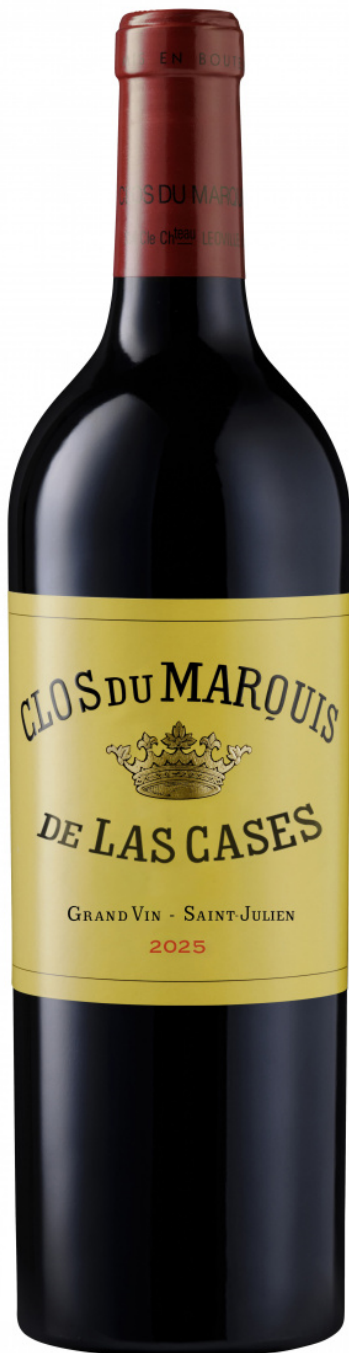

TASTING NOTES

From Terrasse 3, Clos du Marquis in the 2025 vintage shows an exceptionally open and relaxed profile. The palate is clear and bright on entry, with fruit that is both precise and layered. On the nose, it is as if morning light falls gently over cherry and bayberry, giving them a soft and tranquil sheen. As the wine unfolds across the palate, notes of violet and iris rise quietly, merging with powdery tannins to weave a finely detailed texture, evoking a sense of understated nobility. For long-time followers of Clos du Marquis, 2025 is a vintage not to be missed.

The parcels are located along the main road toward Pauillac, not far from Château Pichon Baron and Château Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande. An intensely fragrant, dark-berry bouquet with wild raspberries, cassis, blueberries, licorice, dark graphite, and floral violet notes. On the compact, rounded palate, the wine is juicy and charming, with a supple texture, finely woven tannins, and subtle salinity. Tightly structured and concentrated, with a firm build and a finish shaped by earthy and herbal nuances, ending with a delicate grip. As so often, a very charming Clos du Marquis.

Deep purple-hued and almost glass-staining, the 2025 Clos du Marquis is a blend of 73% Cabernet Sauvignon, 21% Merlot, and 6% Cabernet Franc that's being raised 16 months in 55% new barriques. Ripe black and blue fruits, graphite, and a crushed stone-like minerality all define the aromatics, and on the palate, it's full-bodied, rich, and concentrated, with ripe, polished tannins and a beautiful overall sense of purity and balance. It checks in at 13.6% alcohol with a pH of 3.57.

Intimate and introspective at first with that slightly sombre, dark-fruited character of the vintage. Incense, patchouli, rose petals, violet, black cherry, blueberry and cassis. The dark fruit is plump and perfectly al dente. Refined, elegant and, like Le Petit Lion but much more so, bulby in its florality more obviously so in the depths of the mid-palate than aromatically. More luminous too, much more layered and with the fine-grained tannins hiding between the layers, delineating and pixelating the fruit. The best ever from here.

THE WINE CELLAR INSIDER/JEFF LEVE

Floral, spicy, and tobacco-stained, you also find currants, blackberries, licorice, cocoa, and a touch of espresso beans in the perfume. Vibrant, energetic, red with dark pit fruits, freshness, and refinement create the palate, The finish packs a good punch with its blackberries, chocolate, and currant profile that starts off strong, and keeps on going. Drink from 2030-2050.

THE WINE DOCTOR/CHRIS KISSACK

I adore the character on the nose of this wine, with dark plum, perfumed cherry, currant and violets, scented with rose petals and incense. This has a seriously beautiful coherence on the palate, showing elegantly poised and svelte fruit, with black cherries and currants, set in a modest texture, wrapped around a core of dark, sinewy and tightly grained tannins. This is a superb St Julien, the palate rolling into a long finish of perfumed and sinewy fruit and grip. This is in the running to be the best Clos de Marquis ever. This is 73% Cabernet Sauvignon, 21% Merlot and 6% Cabernet Franc, picked at a yield of 24 hl/ha, the harvest beginning September 8th, finishing on the 20th. This is the third year this has been vinified in the new facilities alongside Léoville-Las-Cases.

Juicy, fruity nose of violets and small red berries. Rather strong taste with a fine interesting fruity layer of fresh cassis and notes of green pepper. A well composed example of the always fleshy, round and seductive style of Clos du Marquis.

THE WINE PALATE/LISA PERROTTI-BROWN

Deep garnet-purple colored, the 2025 Clos du Marquis hops from the glass with vibrant notes of crushed blackberries and black currant jelly, giving way to nuances of rose bud tea, garrigue, and pencil shavings. The medium-bodied palate is wonderfully elegant and finely knit yet intense, delivering bright black fruit layers with mineral sparks, finishing long and refreshing. The blend is 73% Cabernet Sauvignon, 21% Merlot, and 6% Cabernet Franc. It has a pH of 3.57 and the alcohol is 13.6%. The wine is aging for 16 months in French barriques, 55% new.

The 2025 Clos du Marquis is a potent, brooding wine. A rush of dark-toned fruit, gravel, incense, licorice, tobacco and scorched earth hits the palate. Cabernet Sauvignon takes the lead, and that very much comes through in the wine's savory character and structural profile. Lavender, mint, dried herbs and chocolate follow as the 2025 gains volume in the glass. There's a lot of wine here. I am looking forward to tasting this in finished form, given its considerable potential.

The 2025 Clos du Marquis was harvested between September 8 and 20 at 24 hl/ha and matured in 55% new oak for a planned 16 months. This has a fragrant and intense bouquet, with just a hint of lavender suffusing the black cherry and blackcurrant scents, more blue fruit surfacing with aeration. The palate is medium-bodied, with a powerful entry, quite precocious licorice-tinged black fruit. A little "heady" in style, I feel that the warmth of that summer comes through more here compared to the Las Cases.

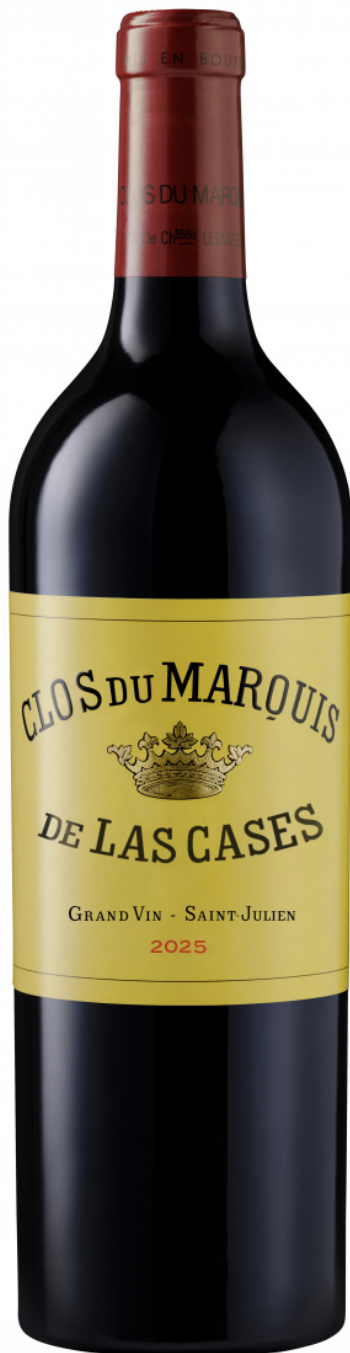
